## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. We cordially invite fellow photographers from around the world to participate in the 1<sup>st</sup> Celbridge International Salon of Photography to be in Celbridge, Co. Kildare, during July 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
2. The Exhibition is open to everyone; however an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable direction, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions.
3. The exhibition comprises of two sections- Color Projected Digital Image Creative Digital image with each exhibitor permitted to enter a maximum of four digital images per section. Digital images are accepted only.
4. This exhibition will be conducted in conformity with the regulations of the Photographic Society of America.
5. Acceptances and awards obtained in this exhibition will count towards PSA "Star Ratings" and "Who's who"
6. Entry fee is \$10.00, which must be paid by Paypal. The receiver is Celbridge Camera Club (Personal check and Postal money order are not acceptable). The entry fee includes the cost of an attractive low resolution color catalogue (CD) and the SURFACE postage of the awards. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT THE ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE JUDGED.
7. The image works must be in digital images only. Each image must be in JPEG format, Maximum size 1400 x 1050, maximum 850kb size. Entries must be submitted via our online entry facility at [www.celbridgecameraclub.net/](http://www.celbridgecameraclub.net/) The organizer will not be held responsible for computer errors in reading the images. Files will not be returned.
9. ALL Digital Images MUST HAVE BEEN EXPOSED BY THE ENTRANT. Entries must originate as photographs (image captures of objects via light sensitivity) acquired digitally or acquired on traditional film and scanned to an electronic file. By submitting an entry the entrant certifies the work as their own and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on the website. The exhibition accepts no liability for any misuse of copyright.
10. Images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker and artwork or computer graphics created by the entrant may be incorporated if the photographic content predominates.
11. An entrants four images will be presented to the judges consecutively. Scoring will be 1 to 5 with a maximum of 15
12. The Salon also will make awards to creative images. Creative photography may be defined as "altered reality" and the concept that stimulates the mind of the viewer to interpret the message conveyed through the creative use of line, form and color. This definition specifically includes computer generated/manipulated images.
13. Images may NOT be entered in more than one section.
14. Awards:
  - PSA AWARDS:

PSA Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each section. In addition, 2 honorable mention ribbons will be awarded.
  - OTHER AWARDS:

1 UPI Gold medal for the best portrait  
3 Judges Medals (Celbridge Silver) – individual awards; and 1 Gold for the best submission of 4 images
